

INTRO TO PORTRAITURE SUPPLY LIST

The Intro to Portraiture Class is an introductory course for students looking to learn how to render the human face. In this 3-session class, you will learn about facial proportions, the relationships between different facial features, and shading. By the end of the course, you will combine the concepts you have learned to produce a fully rendered portrait drawing.

Pencils:

- 2H
- HB
- 2B
- 4B

Erasers:

- Kneaded eraser
- White eraser

Sketchbook:

- Hardbound around 8.5" x 11"

Please get one that is bound like a book with hard covers. Spiral bound ones may get in the way of your hand and the pages fall out very easily from the glue bound books.

Miscellaneous:

- Tracing paper
- Ruler
- Pencil sharpener
- A printed-out photo of someone you would like to draw. The photo should be cropped down to their face and shot head on, as that is the easiest angle to draw from.
